I strongly support the BGSPA submission you have received referring to the situation in Gloucester.

Please do everything in your power to halt CSG projects until the effects of this industry here and overseas have been considered by independent scientists over the long term . I believe that information from extractive industry companies is inherently biased and to date in Australia rigorous independent scientific exploration has been dangerously limited . The future of our health, earning capacity, water and food security is at stake. The risks are too high to proceed in this industry without absolute certainty of safety .
